## Totems News

While the rest of the Totems have had a quiet August, McKenna Dahl has been busy enough for the entire team.

For those not familiar with McKenna, she is a disabled air rifle shooter who shoots from a wheelchair. The category she competes in the SH2. An SH2 rating means that the shooter is not able to hold a rifle without support. McKenna utilizes a spring stand attached to her wheelchair.

Back in July, she attended the International Paralympic Committee's World Cup Match at Stokes-Mandeville in Great Britain. About a week after her return, she headed off to Washington DC where she attended the NRA's Youth Education Summit where she meet leaders from congress, the NRA and special speakers. She also participated in competitive debates where the prizes included \$30,000 in scholarship money.

After McKenna's tour of DC she spent a short time at home before she headed off to Bangkok Thailand where she once again represented the US in the last IPC World Cup match of the season.

McKenna finished 10th in the R3 Air Rifle Prone Mixed SH2 event. In the R4 Air Rifle Standing Mixed SH2 event she finished 5th.

In her final match, Falling Targets, she had 2 1/2 minutes to break 5 discs each smaller than the previous. The winner is determined by time and the number of breaks. McKenna won her first gold medal in this event. A big congrats!
