Totems News

The Totems were busy in the month of December. The team shot both the Junior Olympic Air Rifle Championship (JO-ARC) and the Junior Olympic Smallbore Rifle Championship (JORC).

The JOARC consisted of 18 teams of three. The Thunderbirds (Casey, Owen, and Alec) shot a 1126-38. The team took 2nd overall losing in a tie break decision against Capitol City Gold who shot a 1126-42. The Chiefs (Owen, Sierra and Jack) finished 6th overall with a 1096-27. The Ravens (Katelynn, Katelynn and Nick) shot a 1062-18 finish 8th and the Wolves (Tanner, Sumner and Vic) shot a 1050-19 to finish 10th.

Vic and Tanner both shot well in their age group and may qualify for the National Championships in Colorado Springs. Alec was the Gold Medalist in the men's competition and won an automatic bid to the National Championships.

The JORC was hosted in West Seattle. The team competition consisted of teams of four. The Thunderbirds (Casey, Owen, Alec and Corinne) dominated the competition, shooting a 2228-67, beating the 2nd place team by 72 points. The Chiefs (Emma, Katelynn, Nick and Sumner) shot a 2138-44 to finish third.

In the men's competition, Alec won the Gold Medal with a

565-19 and the automatic entry to the National Championships. Owen shot a 555-20 to capture the Bronze Medal and awaits a possible invite to nationals. Vic is on the borderline and may get an invitation to nationals.

In the women's competitions, Casey won the Gold Medal with a 554-16. Corinne took the Silver Medal with a 554-12. Casey will receive the automatic entry to nations, Corinne will await a possible entry based upon her score.
