“The Juniors just completed Sectionals and here are the results:

2014 Stan Mar Memorial NRA Jr Smallbore Sectional- Individual: Alec earned the overall gold from the sub junior division with a 398. Silver went to Owen with a 397 from the intermediate junior division. Jaelyn, also from intermediate junior earned bronze with a 395.

2014 Stan Mar Memorial NRA Jr Smallbore Sectional- Team: The Totems swept the podium, earning gold, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places. The Thunderbirds earned gold with a combined score of 1580. The Chiefs earned 1562 in 2<sup>nd</sup> place, and the Ravens earned 1543 in 3<sup>rd</sup>.

2014 Fred Burr Memorial NRA Jr Intl Air Rifle Sectional- Individual: Gold went to Casey with a score of 387 from intermediate junior. Silver went to Alec with 385 from sub junior. Bronze went to Corinne with a 384 from intermediate junior.

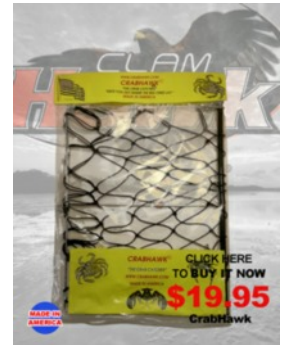

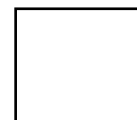
