Thinking About Hunting?

If you're not thinking about hunting, you're not thinking about hunting!

This is the time of the year to begin to plan your fall hunting trip. The 2015 hunting regulations are due out soon.

Deer and elk hunters have until March 31 to enter their name in a drawing for a 2015 multiple-season permit, which can greatly increase opportunities for success in the field.

Hunters may purchase a multiple-season permit application at an authorized license dealer, listed at <http://wdfw.wa.gov/licensing/vendors/>, or by calling (866) 246-9453. The permit application is \$7.10 for residents. A 2015 hunting license is not required to submit an application, but winners of the drawing must purchase one before they can purchase a multiple-season tag.

Hunting licenses and multiple-season tags can be purchased from local license dealers, on the Internet (<http://fishhunt.dfw.wa.gov/>) or by calling (866) 246-9453. Including transaction fees, multiple-season deer tags cost \$139.10 for residents or non-residents, in addition to the cost of an annual hunting license, while elk tags cost \$182.00 for residents and nonresidents in addition to the cost of an annual hunting license. Metric Position Sectionals Results:

Sub-Junior team took home the big honors this week. The Coyotes broke 2 national records this weekend. First to fall was the 3x20 Metric Position Smallbore, Metallic Sights record at 50ft. Then they they went on the set the record for the 3x40 Metric Position Smallbore, Any Sights record at 50ft. Congrats to the Coyotes (Emme, Ben, Luke and Trevor) Alec set the 3x40 national record shooting a personal best 1164 in the Open Metric Sectional. He also shot a personal best in the Jr Metric Sectional with a 580. Alec won the gold medal in both events.

Owen took the silver in the Open Sectional shooting a personal best 1137.

Sierra took the bronze in both events, shooting a 553 and and 1115, both personal bests.

Casey took the bronze in the Jr Sectional with a 555, just edging out Keith of Capitol City in a tie break.

Emily Won the silver in the Jr Sectional with a 571.

Personal bests were shot by Abigail M, Emme, Mike, Lawrence, Ethan, and Trevor

In the team competition, the Thunderbirds (Alec, Owen, Casey, Sierra) won the Gold Medal in both sectionals. They shot a 2232 in the Jr sectional, and a 4508 in the open sectional.

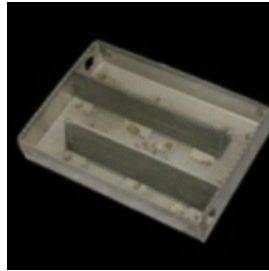

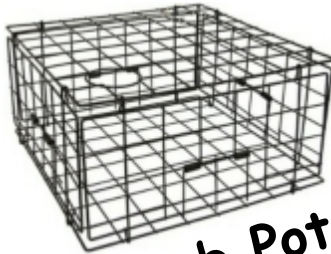
