

WSSC JUNIOR SHOOTING POLICY:

APPLIES TO ANYONE UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

All Juniors must comply with the posted Range Rules in addition to the following:

1. All Junior shooters must have a parent or adult guardian present at the range while they are shooting.
2. All Junior shooters must have a parent or adult guardian sign a Liability Waiver prior to shooting.
3. All Junior shooters must take the WSSC Basic Firearm Safety and Marksmanship course prior to shooting.
4. All Junior shooters who have not passed the NRA Basic Rifle Shooting course must have a competent adult directly supervising them while shooting.

Important note: a competent adult supervising a Junior must have passed an NRA Basic Rifle Shooting Course or hold a Sharpshooter or better marksmanship classification with a nationally recognized marksmanship organization.

5. A Range Master or designated Range Control Officer must be supervising the firing line at all times when Juniors are present.
6. Juniors who are members of a national marksmanship organization who have achieved the rating of Sharpshooter or have passed the NRA Basic Rifle Shooting Course may be under the voice control of a designated Line Officer during an organized competition.
7. All Juniors must achieve a Sharpshooter or better marksmanship classification with a nationally recognized marksmanship organization in order to shoot firearms (.22).
8. No one under 16 may shoot .22 pistol.
9. Any Juniors over the age of 16 must have a pistol training card in order to shoot .22 pistol.
